In 1972 the trustees of Camp Moore donated the camp to The New Jersey State Elks Association, with the understanding it would continue to operate as a camp and that the name of A. Harry Moore, a former governor of New Jersey, be carried on in perpetuity.

The New Jersey State Elks Association through the efforts of many local Elk lodges across the state, have accepted the challenge to serve the Children with Developmental Disabilities in New Jersey.

The camp is composed of 18 air conditioned modern buildings that are wheelchair accessible. Among the buildings are 3 dormitories, a two story dining hall, a kitchen, arts and crafts, game room and fully equipped infirmary. The wheelchair accessible heated pool is only one of the highlights of a week at camp!

The camp staff includes a professional camp director, with a staff of 70 counselors and full time nursing staff. This makes a week at camp a very rewarding experience. A special bond is formed with each and every camper.

The camp is open to all children with special needs between the ages of 7 and 17 years of age during, July and August with respite weekends for campers over 18 in spring and fall.

With many hours of volunteering the Elk members have made Elks Camp Moore a "MIRACLE ON THE MOUNTAIN".
